New York State CDBG-DR Application Available for Review

The Town of Islip announces that it intends to submit an application for New York State Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program funds on or about October 16, 2015 for the following project:

Greater Bay Shore Resiliency Generators Project

Activity: New York State CDBG-DR funds will be used to purchase and install eight (8) permanent generators at seven (7) critical facilities within the Greater Bay Shore Community.

Objective: Installing permanent generators at these seven Community sites will provide a reliable and sufficient supply of electricity to ensure that emergency and rescue services are uninterrupted and critical facilities are operating at maximum capacity during future storms and other emergencies.

Location: The target area includes the Hamlets of Bay Shore and West Bay Shore and the Village of Brightwaters, all located within the Town of Islip.

Amount: \$1,492,189.12 for Design and Construction.

A copy of the application will be available for review during normal business hours at Islip Town Hall, 655 Main Street, Islip, NY subject to the submission of a F.O.I.L. request and the restrictions set forth by New York State Law.

All citizens, particularly persons of low- and moderate-income and residents of blighted areas, as well as those affected by the project are encouraged to submit their comments, views and proposals by October 15 at 11:00 A.M. to the Town at the following address:
